# Parish Financial Crisis – Emergency Appeal

We hope you are all managing to keep well during the pandemic and lockdown.

Prior to the lockdown, the Parish finances were becoming ever more challenging with a mounting deficit between costs and income. This situation has been dramatically exacerbated by the lockdown. The purpose of this letter is to seek every parishioner's assistance in stabilising our finances before the situation becomes catastrophic.

The Parish's costs remain high, even after taking advantage of the government's furlough scheme to reduce staff costs. The Parish's main income comes from the Offertory Collection, either via Bankers Order or basket collection and it will be obvious that the latter has not been forthcoming for the last couple of months and may be for some months to come. We suspect that even when the church is able to reopen, many parishioners will choose to continue to self-isolate and we therefore don't expect a return to normal any time soon.

We are asking for your urgent help through one or more of the following:

**One off donations**: We would ask everyone to consider if they can make a emergency donation via a cash, cheque or BACS. Donations can be Gift-Aided if you are a tax-payer and all we need is a Gift Aid Declaration via Envelope or GAD form. Please see details on page 2.

**Offertory Envelopes:** Those who use the envelope system, please consider using one of the coloured envelopes to make a donation, please also consider missed donations throughout the shutdown.

**Bankers Order:** Setting up a regular monthly donation that will have longer term benefits to the parish's financial planning. If you or your partner are a tax payer we can also benefit from Gift-Aid on these donations.

Those who already support the church though this method, could you consider increasing your regular donations?

As the Parish moves to the "Next Normal" we expect finances to be a continued challenge so would ask you for your continued support.
