### THIS WEEKEND IS SEA SUNDAY

Seafarers and fishers play a vital role in all of our lives, but they often work in difficult, hazardous conditions. In the last year, more crews have been abandoned by their employers than ever before. Many are still being denied the right to leave their ships for even a short break away from the relentless noise and pressure onboard. Many are reporting more stress and poorer mental health. Sea Sunday is **Sunday 10th July**. It is when the Church prays for all those who live and work at sea. Your support will make a big difference to seafarers and fishers in need. ### FIRST HOLY COMMUNION

A very big thank you everyone for all your help and support in the celebration of our First Holy Communion Day on 19th June. It was a beautiful, joyful Mass, as 24 of our children received Jesus for the first time, with their families and friends. Fr Chris has the certificates for those who were unable to attend the 'Go Forth' Mass. The photographs will be at back of church this weekend for you to view and place orders, these usually only take a week or so to arrive and will be at the back of church for collection.

### BUILDING WORKS

You may have seen new wooden panels covering the lintels in the hall and a fenced off area next to the car park. We have now received the results of a survey commissioned to inspect structural problems in the Day Chapel. The large concrete lintels across the back of the church have degraded to the point where they are crumbling and must be replaced. Additionally, bowing of the stained glass windows must be addressed and extensive re-pointing is required on the outside of the church if we are not to have a much larger problem in the future. These challenges add to £20,000 of urgent repairs that must be done to keep the Presbytery weatherproof. Unfortunately, the total cost of this work is expected to greatly exceed the existing parish reserves of about £72,000. Bishop Richard has recently said that we should continue to invest in the Parish buildings, so the Finance and Pastoral Committees are working to refine costs and look at options for fundraising.
