## **BUILDING RESTORATION WORKS – 2<sup>nd</sup> PHASE**

## Commencing Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> May for approximately 15 weeks Monday to Friday 8.00am to 4.30pm

From 27<sup>th</sup> May work will commence to replace the ageing roof structures at St Michael's. This will include replacement of the decking, the insulation beneath and removal of the coping stones atop the parapet wall around the roof. There will inevitably be some noise but the contractors will do their best to keep this to a minimum.

Large vehicles will be accessing the site during the week commencing **Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> May** as scaffolding is delivered and erected. For part of this week, and for the final week of the work (nominally w/c Monday 8<sup>th</sup> September), the drive and car park will be closed. There will be other intermittent restrictions throughout the contract as materials are delivered and skips exchanged.

As last year, there will be a work cabin and fenced area at the northern end of the car park for the period of the works.

Work will be undertaken Monday to Friday 8.00am to 4.30pm, with no <u>work carried out at</u> <u>weekends</u>. The car park will also be used by construction vehicles, resulting in restricted use by other users. **When parking on the road, please be considerate of our neighbours and do** *not park too close to our entrance as long vehicles will have to swing in and out.* 

Foot access to the church will be available at the usual times and we ask our visitors to take care on the site during these works and **observe all safety notices**. Our services will continue as usual although noise will inevitably be experienced inside the building due to the nature of these works.

We thank our neighbours, hall users and parishioners for bearing with us during this time and look forward to completion of the works as quickly as possible.
