WORLD COMMUNICATIONS DAY – 27 May 2025 'Share with gentleness the hope that is in your hearts'

In the first days of Pope Leo XIV's pontificate, he has spoken frequently of the need for peace. In an audience with media professionals days after his election, he made a call for communication to foster peace by caring for how people and events are presented. He invited those present to promote a different kind of communication, one that "does not seek consensus at all costs, does not use aggressive words, does not follow the culture of competition, and never separates the search for truth from the love with which we must humbly seek it. The way we communicate is of fundamental importance, we must say 'no' to the war of words and images; we must reject the paradigm of war." In conclusion, Pope Leo XIV echoed Pope Francis' Message for the 2025 World Day of Social Communication:
