Nine-year-old Santhosh has faced a lot of hardships from a very young age. When he was only six months old, his mother committed suicide because of difficult family problems. Since then, his grandparents have looked after him. His father is physically challenged and can only find occasional work as a painter, making it impossible for him to care for his son. Now, as his grandparents have grown older and weaker, they have found it increasingly difficult to look after Santhosh and give him the future he deserves. Seeing the family's deeply painful situation, we welcomed Santhosh into the Children's Village. He is now safe, happy, and receiving healthy food every day. In June, he will start a bright new chapter in the 4th Standard at St Peter's Primary School, where he will get a good education in a loving environment.

**What can YOU do:**
